Round one found a strong breeze and all but one fell well short of the 15 minute max (Bob Anson 14min/37 sec).

It was decided because of the haze factor the motor run would be reduced to 30 sec. Showing their flying skills most of the pilots rallied to some very good scores and lengthy times even though the motor run was reduced by 15 seconds. Proof of this is 7 of the 9 pilots had flying times of 11 minutes or more . How's that for adjusting to the elements!!! Tops in the second round was Pedro Brantuas with those wonderful flaps scoring an impressive 14min/32sec with a 30pt landing bullseye.

The third round was rather uneventful with the scores ranging from 66 (Pedro) downward. The honors for length of flight in this final round go to Andy Reynolds with a time of 8min/2secs.
